Requirement for Young Tibetans

Entrance Test and Interview

Selection

The final selection of the 4 males and 6 females will be done by Vana. Vana will bear their travel expenses such as train by IIIAC, deluxe bus, auto fare and accommodation for one night in a hotel not exceeding Rs. 600/- to Dharamsala for the training.

Salary & entitlements

The selected Tibetans undergoing the 6-month training will be entitled to a monthly stipend of Rs. 6,000/- for his/her food and accommodation. After completion of the training, the candidates will work at either of the locations of Vana i.e. Delhi or Dehradun as suggested by Vana team, for a three year commitment. The salary range would be from 2.0–3.0 lakhs per annum (including accommodation). In addition, the candidates joining Vana would be eligible for the benefits of Health, Life and Group Personal Accident Insurance, meals on shift, team transport facility as per our policy, usage of team gym and recreation facilities.
